

***The requirements for someone who would like to do the three-year retreat at Karme Ling are as follows:***

***(1) The ability to chant Tibetan fast (comprehension is not necessary)***

I can chant very quickly in Tibetan

***(2) The completion of 111,111 repetitions of the four foundations of Ngondro***

I have completed the four foundations of Ngondro with 111,111 repetitions. Additionally, I am nearly finished with my second full set of four Ngondro foundations.

***(3) Good physical and mental health***

I am physically and mentally fit for three year retreat. My weight is nearly 140lbs at 5'11", and my physique is slightly toned. Each day I do about two hours of cardio, in addition to a regular 108 daily prostrations. I have no known diseases, conditions, allergies, or hindrances to my health in any way whatsoever. Mentally, I am energetic, inspired, and feel generally very well. My love for the dharma, as well as making efforts in daily life to be a positive example, as well as to bring joy and laughter to others, keeps my spirits up.

***(4) \$36,000 retreat fee (NOTE: the Karme Ling website says \$25,000, but this is outdated. The cost for the 2026 three-year retreat is \$36,000. See acceptance letter from Lama Karma Lodro for updated cost)***

I have about \$23,000 in my personal checking account, and in addition to seeking support from the Tsadra Foundation, I have sought and have been granted partial support from my mother.

*(5) The ability to read, write, and speak English fluently*

As English is my native language, all of these requirements are completely satisfied with no impediment whatsoever.

*(6) Permission from the Retreat Master*

I have sought and have been granted permission from the Retreat Master, Lama Tsultrim Gyalsten. Additionally, I have been approved by the Karme Ling manager, Lama Karma Lodro. (*See application for letter of acceptance*)

*(7) Letter of recommendation from main teacher*

My main teacher, Lama Yeshe Palmo, has sent her letter of recommendation to the Tsadra Foundation in conjunction with my application submission.
