Dear Tsadra Scholarship Committee,

I am very honored to be able to write a letter of recommendation for Heidrun I. Köppl ("Heidi"), from Austria. I have known Heidi for over 30 years, as friends, as classmates, and as dharma sisters. We lived together for eight years in a small bungalow in the compound of Ka-Nying Shedrub Ling monastery, Boudhanath, Nepal, and have been very close ever since. We studied together for some years at the University of Vienna (Tibetology and Buddhism), at Tribuwan University, Nepal (Tibetan and Sanskrit), and at Rangjung Yeshe Institute, Nepal (Buddhist philosophy). We went on pilgrimages together to Tibet, India, Bhutan, etc. and did several six-weeks and three-months retreats together in Gomde Germany-Austria and in Gomde Pyrenees.

This program has about 1000 participants, not only online, but also hosts seminars, retreats, often taught by Heidi herself. Heidi also is one of Chökyi Nyima Rinpoche's main translators, interpreting from Tibetan to English and German at many seminars and retreats, not only for him, but also for other high lamas, such as Chokling Rinpoche, Phakchok Rinpoche, Tsoknyi Rinpoche etc. She has done many retreats, often also translating for the retreat lama. Heidi also wrote several books and translated many texts for Dharmachakra Translation Group, etc. Heidi does all of this out of her immense compassion of wanting to benefit beings, to lead everyone to ultimate awakening.

Thus Heidi has fulfilled the wish of her master Chökyi Nyima Rinpoche to become an authentic dharma practitioner, fully engaged in unbroken practice and constantly benefiting beings. She is truly a rare jewel in this world!
